

## Directions to Siamsa Training Centre

Siamsa Training Centre is nestled beautifully in the rolling hillside of rural North County Meath. It is a perfect tranquil space for your training events, retreats or CBT sessions.

To help you find us, we've prepared these directions. Coming from Dublin you have two choices: take the M1 route which goes via the airport towards Belfast or the N2 route which goes to Derry via Ashbourne. The M1 Route is more straightforward.

If you follow them to the 'letter' you will not get lost. If you do, don't worry, just call us!

### From M1 (Dublin to Belfast Motorway)

Take the **M1 North Bound** and continue until you meet the exit 14 for **Ardee / Derry**. This will take you about 35 mins to reach. Exit here and follow the signs for **Ardee/ Derry N2** road at the top of the exit. Continue on this road for about 4 miles until you come to the first roundabout. Go straight through this. You will come to another **roundabout**, again go straight through this following the **Derry N2 road**. (You will not be going into the town of Ardee.) About 100 yds there is another roundabout you will take the **second exit** off this for **Carrickmacross / Derry**. **Exactly 5.5km** from this exit is a turn to the **left (road number L5199) sign posted for Churchtown**. Continue on this road and go straight through the next crossroads. The next part of this road is narrow and has a lot of bends on it so be careful. Continue to the next crossroads which is roughly 2.5 miles. Turn left here. The centre is the next avenue on the right about 100 metres from this crossroads. The peers are cream and light green. You will not see the house from the road. Go straight up the hill to the end of the avenue and into the car park at the top of the hill. If you follow these instructions to the letter you should not get lost. At the entrance there is a sign on a rock on the ground for **Siamsa**. You will not see the centre from the road. If you find yourselves in difficulty just phone 086-8162066 or 041-6854616 and I will come and rescue you!! Journey time from Dublin Airport is 55mins if you don't get lost!!

### From N2 (Ashbourne to Derry)

Take the **N2 Ashbourne/Derry Rd** out of Dublin. Continue until you come to **Slane**. In the middle of the village take the **left turn at the crossroads** marked for **Navan/kells**. Continue for 1 mile until you come to **Slane Castle** on your left. Take the **right turn** at the castle marked **Kells**. Continue on this road. The road for Kells will veer to the left. **DO NOT** take this road. Continue straight. This is the **Drumconrath Road**. Be careful as it swings to the right just after the turn for Kells. Stay on this road for 20 mins until you reach the village of **Drumconrath**. You will go through many crossroads and some you will have to stop at but don't veer off this road. Straight through all the crossroads including the one with O'Donoghues Pub on the corner. Straight through all the way. You will come into the village of Drumconrath at a **T junction**. Take the left and continue through the village. 150 metres take the **right** signed **Carrickmacross**. It is at a white railings at the church. Continue for less than 2 miles and take the right turn marked with a brown sign for **Balrath Lake**. (ignore another sign previous to this for Cortown lake). Continue for half mile and take right turn at the next crossroads. I am 100 yds on the right. The centre has cream and light green walls. Go up the lane and follow sign for car park at the top of the hill. You will not see the centre from the road. Journey time from **Slane** max 30 mins if you don't get lost!
